PLANS FOR A NEW PUBLIC-HOUSE

PLANS for a new public-house at Lawrence Weston were revealed last night at the annual dinner of the Bristol Hop Leaf Skittles League.

Mr. B. H. Quelch, area manager of H. and G. Simonds, Ltd., said his firm had acquired a site at Lawrence Weston and proposed building new premises if the plans met with the approval of the Bristol licensing authorities. The new hotel would be named Giant Goram.
